AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

Closing date for entries is Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at the Test Site. Day of event entries will be accepted if space is available. No entry will be accepted without payment and signature.

It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date.

Make all checks and money orders payable to: French Creek Pet Resort. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. A fee of \$25 will be charged for any returned check. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Any entry sent via express mail or any other similar service must be sent "no signature required".

By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. If you would like your confirmation letter and judging program sent via US Postal Service, you may either not provide your email address on your entry or you may specifically request US Postal Service mail.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

French Creek Pet Resort accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry from instructions and Rules Applying to Dog Shows (Rules) of the American Kennel Club. From time to time, these are subject to change. In the event of a discrepancy in these entry form instructions, Agreement and rules versus the text within the entry from you sign and submit, the AKC Agreement entry form instructions and rules in effect at the time these entries close will take precedence.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

GENERAL TEST REQUIREMENTS

Non-competitive pass/fail evaluation of a dog's ability to exhibit self-control in a rural farm setting.

Open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program. Females in season may not enter.

Safety is paramount. Farm site must be well maintained, with fences, gates and equipment in good working order. All livestock must be in good condition, provided with fresh water, clean housing, and confined to dog proof enclosures during the test evaluation.

The Judge must have at least one assistant to aid in administering the test.

Dogs must be on leash at all times while on farm site unless confined in a crate, kennel or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length.

Dog must wear a secure, well fitting flat collar during the test evaluation.

Handlers can use verbal cues, hand signals and praise provided it is not excessive in the opinion of the judge.

Dogs may attempt each test element no more than two times.

Dogs must pass all elements of the test and overall assessment during the same test to qualify.

Dogs must qualify under to different judges in order to qualify to be awarded the FDC suffix title

The judge may discontinue testing if he/she determines the dog is too fearful or under duress to perform the required elements.

The Judge may request the removal of any dog from the immediate test area at any time, if he/she determines the presence of the dog presents a risk to livestock, other dogs, or person on the farm.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Farm Dog Certified Tests by downloading from the American Kennel Club Website.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Test Site: Parking in designated spaces only. Please park in front of a designated parking sign. If there is no sign, you cannot park there. Speed limit at the test site is 5mph. This is a working farm / dog facility and safety of the animals takes precedence. If you are running late, that does not excuse violating the speed limit.

No smoking on site

Spectator area: Spectators are limited due to COVID restrictions still in place. Exhibitors, family members and friends are welcome to watch the test in progress as long as they do not interfere in that test and observe all physical distancing / mask / sanitation rules mandated by the State at the time of the test.

French Creek Pet Resort is not responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the test site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused with the benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations at the test site. Please use the designated potty area for your dog. Do not allow your dog to potty on structures such as buildings, potted plants, portable toilets, etc. Use the designated potty area.

RIBBONS AWARDS AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

Qualifying score Dark Green

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, since this is a working farm, drugs may be in use that can cause harm to dogs with slight traces found in animal waste. For example, Ivermectin which can harm certain dogs, is a common drug for the treatment of livestock diseases.

DIRECTIONS TO FRENCH CREEK PET RESORT

From I-5 in Everett, take the HWY 2 exit going east towards Monroe. From Monroe, take HWY 2 west towards Everett.

From HWY 2, turn on 100th St SE (Westwick Road)

This only goes one direction. It will be on your left if coming from Everett and on your right if coming from Monroe.

Follow 100th (Westwick) for 2.3 miles. This will take you past French Creek Manor on your right and around a big bend in the road.

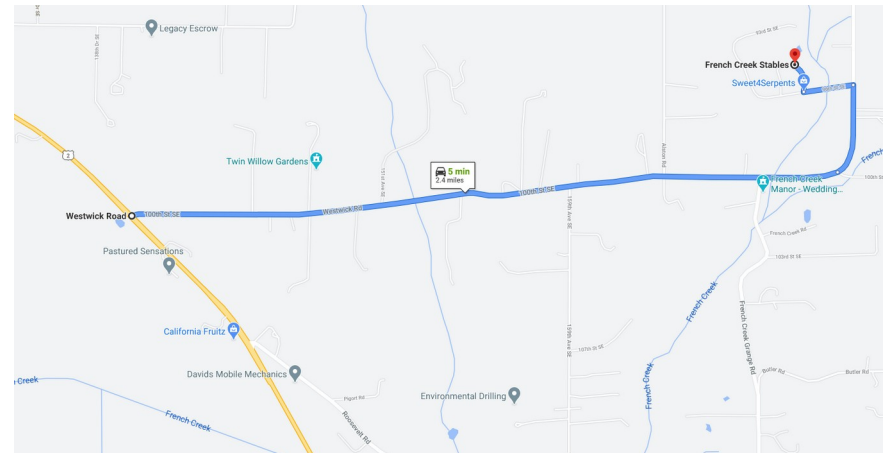
Just past the bend, take a left on 96th St SE. There will be a sign for French Creek Stables.

Drive slowly, the speed limit on this road is 25mph

At the bottom of the hill, turn right at the signs for the French Creek manager and Sno-King Agility. This is a very short dirt lane with a 5mph speed limit.

The parking lot is at the end of the short dirt lane.

If you plug the address into your GPS, the directions are accurate. It previously was known as French Creek Stables and may show up that way in your map application.
